Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Dyan 3:19 I duen Dwata mlayam i dad to ani, du tasalu agu, i salò, dini di tah tanà, bay én balingla too knayè i kifu, na knangla i kalwa, du sasè i nimòla.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Dyan 6:40 Du ani too knayè Màngu, ku balù simto to mite deg i Tingaan, na faglut di deg, gfunan nawa landè sen, na ntékgu kenen mdà di fati kadang di fulé duh.”

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Dyan 14:6 Dyan 14:6 Na man Dyisas di kenen, “Agu i dalan salu ditù, na agu i gumdà i kaglut na falami nawa. Landè to fakay salu di Mà ku laan funa magu di deg.

Dyan 3:17 Du ise én duen Dwata mdek i Tingaan dini di tah tanà du mlayam i dad to, bay dekan dini du fye falwaan dad to di dad salàla.

Dyan 1:10,12 Mnè kenen dini di tah tanà mgimò fagu di kenen, bay knean, là dilè i dad to ku simto kenen. Kabay i dad to dmawat na faglut di kenen, banlén kaglut du fye mbaling ale dad ngà Dwata.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God’s word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

Dyan 10:28 Banlégu ale nawa landè sen, na là ale malmo di salàla, na landè gamlad dale mdà di deg,



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you.
