

GOD'S SIMPLE PLAN OF SALVATION

Introduction

The Bible is very clear that you can know for sure that when you die that you can go to heaven. The question is do you believe what God says in his word.

1 John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

I We are all sinners!

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Taga-Ruma 3:10 "Su tùtu-u to impasulat to Diyus natodu-on no nig-iling to "Wadà matuwadong, agad sobu-uk:"

Taga-Ruma 3:23 "Su tibò to mgo otow, namakasaà du-on to Diyus. Wadà ogkasayà to Diyus no matuwadong to paghimu din."

Taga-Ruma 5:12 "Na og-indanan now so-idi no mgo kalinikatan. Pagkas ood to saà so-idi kalibutan, songo otow dà to pinabayà. Naka-agad gayod nakasood to kamatayon no pinabayà sikan no saà. Kaling man so-idi nalangkoban to langit, nasakupan to kamatayon tsu tibò to mgo otow, nakasaà:"



We are all sinners!

II There is a cost for that sin!

Taga-Ruma 6:23 “Su sikan pig-ikagi ku, tütu-u iyan su to bayad to saà, kamatayon no iyan pagluwat to Diyus to mgo otow no wadà katapusan. Dì to inghungyam to Diyus, kinabuhì no konad ogkawadà no pinabayà dà ki Jesu-Kristu no Magbobo-ot ta.”

Revelation 21:8 “But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.”

Revelation 20:12-15

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

III Christ died for our sins.

Taga-Ruma 5:6 “Na nokoy to igkapatu-u to dakoo to logon ita to Diyus. Ogdomdoman ta pad to pagpakimatoy ni Jesus ita no nasakupan ki pad to saà ta, wadà kabogbogan ta no igkalipwas ta to ita no lawa. Dì pagkagotò to adow, si Jesu-Kristu to nigpakimtoy ita no makasasaà.”

Taga-Ruma 5:8 “Dì ita, agad sala-an ki no mgo otow, di pigka-atan kid to Diyus nasi su nigpakimatoy ita si Jesu-Kristu.”

Taga-Ruma 14:9 “For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.”

Taga-Ruma 6:23 “Su sikan pig-ikagi ku, tütu-u iyan su to bayad to saà, kamatayon no iyan pagluwat to Diyus to mgo otow no wadà katapusan. Dì to inghungyam to Diyus, kinabuhì no konad ogkawadà no pinabayà dà ki Jesu-Kristu no Magbobo-ot ta.”



Christ died for sinners!

IV Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!

Taga-Ipisu 2:8-9 “Iyu gayod, to kalipwasanan now, kabo-ot dà to Diyus to piglikatan no wadà now pa-abuta dì pinabayà iyan to pagtu-u now ki Jesus. Dì agad pagtu-u now, wadà likat iyu. Dì kabo-ot gayod to Diyus to piglikatan to pagtu-u now. Agad dow pighimu now, madoyow dì wadà gayod tuguti to Diyus to ogkahimu sikan no piglikatan to kalipwasanan now su dagow masayà now to iyu tu-un no lawa.”

Titus 3:5 “Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;”

Acts 4:12 “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”



V We must put our faith and trust in Christ in order to be saved.

Taga-Ruma 4:24 “But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;”

Taga-Ruma 10:9-10, 13 “Su to tu-un ta no bàbà, ko pakanangon ki to si Jesus, Magbobo-ot ta, aw ko matibuus to ginhawa ta to pagtu-u ta ki Jesus no pigbuhoy to Diyus aw tuusa, ogkalipwasan ki iyan. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Ko nabogayan ki to pa-antihan, tahan ta dà iyan no otow tibò. Dì ogkasaligan ta to Diyus to konà ogtugutan to ogpabogayan ki to pa-antihan no konà ta ogkatuwa-ay su ma-ongod-ongodon kandin. Dì ko mabogayan ki to pa-antihan, ogkabogayan ki gayod to Diyus to igkalipwas ta hantod to matuwa-ay ta.

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If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.

"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin, which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
